mu-guyiya	dogs balls, <i>Grewia retusifolia</i>
mu-burpba	(1) rifle; (2) lily
?-nurritj	a green aquatic weed
mu-jukgul	<i>Acacia holosericea</i> . Spear wood in spring country.
gu-worrongomoloh	<i>Alloteropsis semialata</i>
gu-munhmunh	(any kind of) grass for making fire (with firestick), kindling
wirriyel	aquatic weed
mu-gutjjung	big lily root
gu-bindiayai	bindi-eye (Kriol loan)
mu-yawok	bitter, cheeky yam cf. Jawoyn yawk, Ngalkbon yawok
mu-wom	black plum
mu-baltjja	?black plum (syn. with mu-wom)
mu-garratjji	black spinifex gum, used for medicine (boiled and then bogey)
gu-dumuluh	bloodwood
mu-murrbunh	broad-leaved <i>Terminalia</i> species
gu-birnday	cane grass
mu-makgurr	cold weather, middle of cold season
mu-mululuk	conkerberry
gu-mutjju	coolibah
?-beje?	coolibah?
gu-giriba	creeper sp., like baramulk, largurrja. ?Kriol, 'yellawan' (poss. a loan from 'creeper')
mu-yerrel	creeper, used for arm decorations, fishing. Lawyer vine.
gu-bardiguluh	<i>E. Ferruginea</i> (?)
mu-warlanh	<i>E. tectifera</i>
mu-laway	<i>Eleocharis dulcis</i> (sedge)
gu?-ngabak	<i>Eucalyptus grandifolia</i>
?-marrangarr	firestick tree?
mu-ngelh	freshwater mangrove
mu-bernberreny	ghost gum
gu?-boromon	grass (hill country spinifex?)
mu-boy	grass species

mu-gurninyarra	'like Leichhardt tree but with a red fruit' Poss. <i>Ficus racemosa</i> . Said to be syn. of <i>mu-warnwarn</i>
gu-ngalkngalk	lily species (Syn. jawhjawh)
mu-barnarrh	marble tree
mu-rokga	Pandanus spiralis
gu-got	paperbark (apparently generic, possible focus on papery bark rather than trees)
mu-bulpbul	paperbark sp.
gu-jirdak	paperbark cooliman
gu-mardu	?paperbark species or cooliman
gu-bitjjurrk	plat potato
gu-galangarndah	plat potato species
gu-jajak	prob. fan palm
mu-jorrowh	quinine bush
gu-derreneh	'red apple', <i>Syzygium sp.</i>
gu-ngolonggoh	river red gum
gu-largurrja	?same as baramulk, ?loan from Marra
gu-majaburrghah	Securinea species
?-wirn.girr	shitwood, for making bush pipes
mu-jupbih	shrub
mu-wartbar	Probably Grevillea pteridifolia
mu-nyamnyam	?sp. of lily
mu-boroh	?sp. of lily, spring country
gu-barrakgarlh	bamboo spear or tree species used for spear shafts. (Spec. blacksoil country, c.f. jukgul) Probably <i>Sesbania cannabina</i>
mu-jalng	spinifex
mu-bilat	splinter
gu-ngatdum	stick devoid of foliage
mu-jitjbu	stringybark
gu-gardaykga	stringybark
mu-danbarr	"stringybark"
gu-wurray	tall grass species
mu-warnwarn	Terminalia grandiflora
gu-mirnitja	thick scrub, poss. <i>Cathormion umbellatum</i>
gu-birdipbirdi	ti tree
mu-gulukgulun	ti tree (melaleuca sp.), small leaves, used for medicine, poss. <i>Melaleuca acacioides</i>
mu-jiliwirn	? <i>Capparis umbonata</i>
mu-jorne	<i>Terminalia canescens</i>

buyuh (or bujuh)	tree sp. found growing at Flying Fox Ck. Used for woomeras, spears.
gu-gunungurk	tree with long leaves, has food for humans and animals
mu-linyman	Triglochin procera
gu-wurrk	unidentified grass species. Possibly just refers to 'grass for burnoff'
mu-jilarra	prob. Gutta percha: <i>Excaecaria parvifolia</i> , same name in Ngandi, Ritharrngu
mu-bulbul	var. of <i>Melaleuca leucadendron</i>
?-durrgu	very large paperbark sp. (found at Flying Fox Ck.)
gu-lungurru	<i>Vigna vexillata</i>
mu-birlal	waterlily leaf
mu-jatdam	waterlily species
gu-/mu-bilabila	wattle tree, has yellow flower (at Flying Fox creek)
mu-balarra	wattle tree, yellow flowers
mu-borogorrh	'whistling tree' <i>Casuarina</i> or <i>Allocasuarina</i> sp.
gu-gare	?whitegum
mu-gurrur	wild 'bush' species of lily root (green flower) , possibly <i>Nymphaea violacea</i>
gu-morrortdinh	Merlan: wild cassava, my informants: wild banana <i>Leichhardtia australis</i>
gu-jiwurru	'wild cassava'
gu-baramulk	?wild cucumber, lives along the river 'redwan'. Poss. baramurk
gu-gayabam	'wild orange' ? <i>Capparis umbonata</i>
mu-ngambirnhngambirnh	wild potato species
gu-mirdark	woodchips
gu-man.gardah	woollybutt
mu-jimit	(?woolybark) ? <i>Planchonella</i> spp.
